Y.A.N.A/Telephone Contact is a volunteer service program offered by the Yucaipa Police Department.

There is no charge for this program.

For millions of American seniors living independently, adults with functional limitations, and homebound individuals, days may pass without human interaction. The Yucaipa Police Department is committed to connecting with people in all of these categories to establish a social safety net.

The You Are Not Alone (YANA) program helps allow seniors, disabled persons, or homebound individuals find comfort and security in regular telephone contact.

Yucaipa Police Volunteers connect with YANA enrollees and develop a genuine interest in their wellbeing. If an enrollee does not respond to a scheduled call, staff will attempt to call an emergency contact kept on file. If the emergency contact is unavailable, a department member responds to the home to check on the enrollee.

The benefits of YANA are numerous, but empowering people to thrive and prosper through compassionate caring is the most important. The Yucaipa Police Department encourages you to take advantage of this free service.
